Dear Parents and Carers,

Firstly, I would like to welcome you back to school and the Spring term. I always feel that this is the term when loads of learning gets done. #### **Emergency School Closure**

In preparation for the potential bad weather, please read the information below to ensure you are aware of our procedures should we have to close the school.

Our priority is the safety of the children. In the event of adverse weather conditions we will make every effort to remain open. We take the view that closing the school can disrupt teaching and learning as well as inconveniencing parents and carers.

The decision to close the school will review a number of factors:

- The conditions on site are considered too dangerous this will include heating and utility factors caused by adverse weather.
- The conditions traveling to and from the school site are considered too dangerous or likely to worsen.
- We receive advice and recommendations from other agencies, including Gloucestershire County Council, local emergency services or transport agencies.
- We are unable to get a sufficient number of staff to the school site to operate safely.

On those occasions where the weather closes in overnight, a decision will be made as early as possible or by 7:30am at the latest. Sometimes, the weather may worsen during the school day. We will notify you of an early closing time should this be the case.

Notification of a school closure will be sent to you directly via Parent Mail – please ensure the school office have an up to date telephone and email contact.
