At the start of the week, we visited St Bartholomew's Church and Reverend Graham introduced our value of 'forgiveness'. Forgiveness is an important part of Christianity. It does not mean that Christians let others get away with things, but more that they make a conscious effort to forgive and let go of feelings that come with bearing a grudge against a person. These feelings of anger and hatred can cause harm to the person feeling them so Jesus taught people to try and let them go. The children thoroughly enjoyed re-enacting The Parable of the Prodigal Son, Matthew 6: 14-15, where the father forgives his son when he returns and welcomes him home. In the same way, God waits for humans to realise what they have done wrong, ask for forgiveness and welcomes them back when they do. During the term, we will be exploring this value in more depth.

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
Afterschool Clubs


