Local family events and activities are included plus a What's On Guide. Activities and Days Out have lots of options for families wanting to get out and about in September and October.


For those staying close to home there are activities including Autumn Crafts, Growing oak trees from acorns and a Black History Month 'Who's Who' Quiz.




Message from Playgroup
