Dear Parents and Carers,

As promised, I am giving you more detail about how our Transition Two-weeks will run from 6th July. I have set the details out on a single page which will be emailed to you along with this newsletter so you can attach it to your fridge or somewhere suitable at home as a reminder as we get nearer the time. The children from Year 2 to Year 5 will be split alphabetically into two groups as this seems to be the fairest way to divide the year groups.

I would like to say a big thank you for bearing with us with what we are trying to do. As I have already said, nothing is ideal and we have gone through every scenario we can think of as a staff in order to facilitate your child coming back to school. There just aren't enough adults and rooms in school to have all the children in at the same time given the current guidance. However, I am really pleased that we can still give the Year 6 children a special day, just for them, to say goodbye properly and give them the send-off they deserve on the very last day of term.

In order to keep your child safe when returning to school, all children will be given hand sanitiser as they enter and leave the school buildings. Children will wash their hands regularly throughout the day and be encouraged to maintain a suitably safe distance whilst in school. Children will remain in their class 'bubbles' throughout the day to avoid cross contamination with other children. Each 'bubble' will have allocated toilets as well as outdoor spaces in our field. School uniform will not be required so clothes can be easily changed each day to minimise risk.

Home learning will continue in a more limited capacity, using Oak National Academy and BBC Bitesize resources. As always paper copies will be available.

We are all really excited to welcome back those children who have not been able to be in school. In the meantime, if you have any problems or concerns please do not hesitate to contact me.
