End of day arrangements

To keep all of our children who attend clubs and wraparound care at the end of the school day safe, we are making a few changes. Please note:

- At the end of the school day, after children have been dismissed, the gates will be closed promptly at **3.25pm**.
- If, due to unforeseen circumstances, you are going to be late collecting your child, please contact the school office in the first instance. Your child will remain with their class teacher for 10 minutes after collection time and then they will be taken to wraparound where you will incur a small fee. Due to meetings, sport fixtures and other commitments that teaching staff have after school, it is important that all parents collect their children on time.



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We are Pied Piper


