Dear Parents and Carers

I hope you have all had a lovely week. I have definitely felt the colder climes of autumn coming and even considered putting the heating on at home for the first time! Luckily, I resorted to another jumper but I think cooler weather is definitely on the way, which does have the bonus of lovely crisp mornings, clear skies and frosty starts.

As you know, we will move to a different set-up for lunches next week. You should have received information earlier in the week on how to book a packed lunch from our school caterers, Caterlink, if you would like to order these. It's the same approach as before, except your child orders from a choice of sandwich fillings, accompanied with other goodies. Please also feel free to bring in a packed lunch from home as normal if you wish to. I can only apologise that our current recruitment crisis has got the better of us. It's not something any of us wanted to do and we have struggled on, but it has become unsustainable and was having a negative impact on staff workload levels and children's learning. Bringing a packed lunch from home or ordering one from Caterlink reduces the time and number of staff needed to safely supervise the children at lunchtime. I only hope we can get some adults through the door as soon as possible to help us so we can revert back to hot dinners. Please let us know if you are willing to help, either on a voluntary basis, employed for a few days or for all 5-days. Any help will be gratefully received.

We are holding our new Reception parents open morning for the September 2024 intake on Wednesday 8th November. A flyer is attached with all the details. Please spread the word, as we think Coaley is such a super place for your child to learn, grow and flourish in the warm embrace of a school family.

About the role
