Talking of routines: I also wanted to talk about homework. Homework will start next Friday for all classes. It was not a full inspection but to see how we have coped with the lockdown and what we are doing to support learners to catch up from this September. It was a really positive experience and they saw and heard lots of great things about our school, and the children behaved beautifully, as you'd expect. I'd particularly like to thank all the staff who were simply amazing, working as a team to show our school to be the brilliant place to learn we know it to be.

In these continuing uncertain times, we do need to be aware how we can all be affected by the pandemic and we will be keeping an extra close eye on your children in school.
