The hours will be every day from 12noon to 1.20pm.

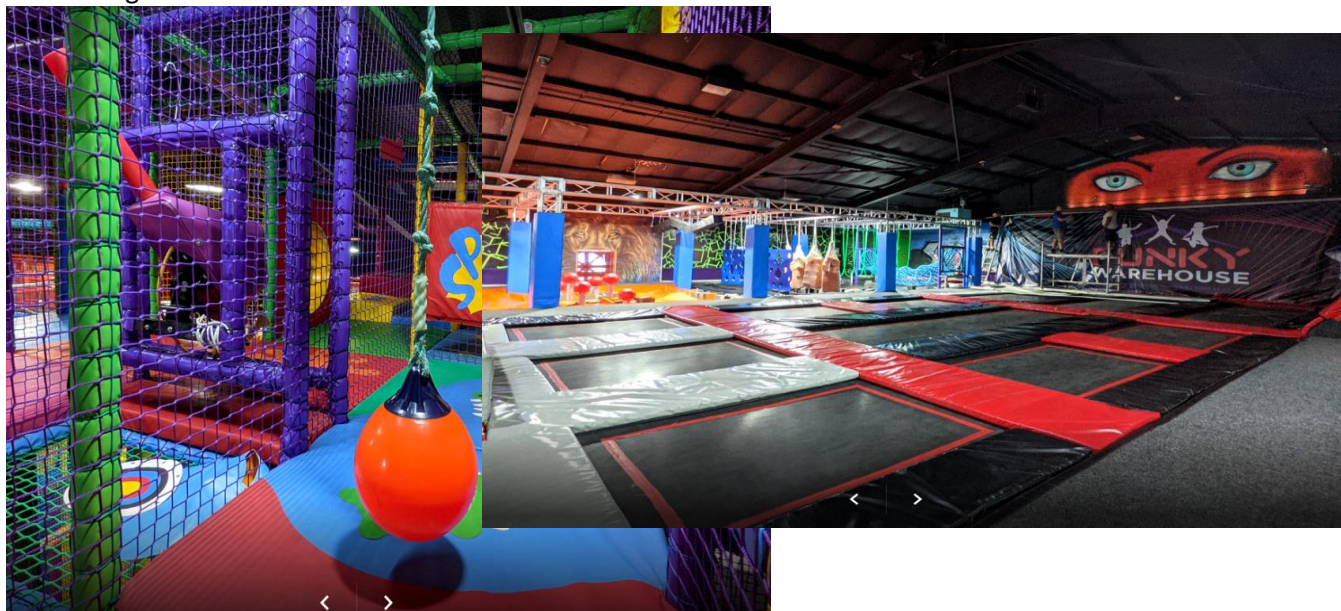
The start date for employment will be Monday 5th September 2022 and continue for the duration of the maternity leave.
